Drive-Thru Communion Distribution

Communion Assistants

Prior to drive-thru communion, those who will be assisting with distribution will gather and celebrate the sacrament with one of the pastors, then the elements will be distributed by a pastor and assistants as you drive up to the distribution station.

Communion Station Layout

The communion station will consist of two tents, each having trays of bread, wine or juice and gluten-free wafers.

Please enter the church property as usual (to the right facing the building from the street), drive around the back of the building, and then on around to the left side.

To Receive Communion

- 1. Pull up between the tents in one line.
- 2. Let the assistant know if you need a gluten-free wafer or grape juice.
- 3. On each side of the car an assistant will hand you a small paper container.
 - a. In each container, there will be a piece of bread and a plastic cup with wine.
 - b. The assistant will say, "The body and blood of Christ given and shed for you."
- 4. Eat the bread and drink the wine.
 - a. Each cup has a drop of glue holding it down to avoid spills, so gently twist (don't pull) it loose to release the cup and drink the wine.
- 5. Take the container and empty cup with you and dispose of it appropriately.
- 6. After receiving communion, please pull forward and exit the parking lot so that those behind you will be able to receive the sacrament.

We thank you for your patience as we share the Eucharist in this unfamiliar way.
