Thanksgiving Feast

On Friday, Nov. 17, we will be providing a Thanksgiving Feast for our students. Your child's feast menu will be chicken nuggets, tater tots, popcorn and applesauce (**no need for your student to bring lunch on this day**). Following lunch the children are inviting their parents for dessert and a small program. The program will start at 12:30pm. Our preschoolers will sing about thanks and hear a story. After the program, feel free to enjoy dessert with your child. There will be **NO** afternoon carpool as school will dismiss after the program.



CARPOOL REMINDERS

1. Please make sure you are providing a carseat for your child when picking them up from preschool. We can not release them if there is no carseat available to them. They may not be buckled up in a seatbelt only!
2. Please buckle your child in their carseat correctly EVERY TIME! If they are not buckled up correctly, they are not safe!
3. Please do not remove your child from their carseat at anytime during drop-off. Accidents can happen in a parking lot and we do not want any of the kids injured because they were not buckled all the way.
4. Please allow a car length between you and the car in front of you while on the hill. Cars naturally roll back when moving forward and we don't want anyone hurt or have any fender-benders.
5. Please stay off your cellphone when carpool line is moving!
6. Please use your carpool numbers while in carpool line. Hold them up or out the window. It makes the line move quickly.
7. Please remember that carpool is not parent/teacher conference time. Keep talking to a minimum. If you need to talk to the teacher a little longer, feel free to pull over to a parking space and we can discuss matters after carpool or with a phone call.

Carseat safety for children is the law whether on public streets or in our private parking lot!
